

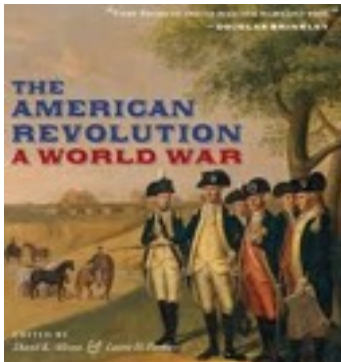
The American Revolution Project Options

Informational Book

Use Pages to write a book containing the following features:

- Front Cover with Title, Image, and Name
- Table of Contents
- Chapters
- Images with Captions
- List of Sources



Optional pages include:

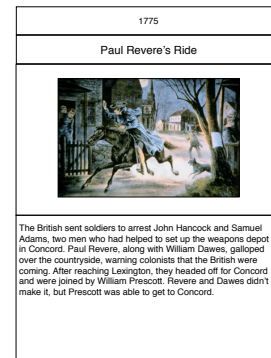
- Bold, Colored, or Italics Print for vocabulary words
- Glossary
- Headings/Subheadings
- Sidebars with additional or related information
- Maps
- Graphs/Charts/Tables
- Timeline
- Copyright Page
- Dedication Page
- Back of the Book Blurb
- About the Author Page
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Upon completion, you will have the option to publish you work as either a paperback or hardcover book. Instructions on how to do this will be provided later.

Timeline

Use a supplied template (printed or in Pages) to create a timeline. Each section must contain:

- the year
 - the topic/event
 - an illustration
 - a summary
- You may choose to print photos or draw the illustrations
 - You may choose to use bullet points or write the summary



Board Game

Design and produce a board game that can be played. You must:

- Come up with an original idea for a game that can be played by 2-6 players
- Construct the game, and all pieces and components necessary to play the game
