Goal - wrap up the essay by connecting to the idea you began with in the introduction

Things you may include:

- 1. Connection to the opening
- 2. Restate the thesis
- 3. Summarize the main points
- 4. Explain the importance Tell why your view on this is relevant. You can do this by making a personal connection between the story and your life or the world.
- 5. Give reader a mission End with a final great thought for the reader to ponder and/or give the reader an action to take.
